
Grade 8 Textbook and Stationery Requirements 2021

Wendywood High School receives an annual grant from the Department of Education for learning and teaching study material (LTSM). This grant does not allow the school to provide a textbook per child per subject per year. The school has devised a payment scheme that will ensure that each child receives a text book on loan for each of the nine learning areas, at a cost far below the actual cost. You are required to pay an amount of R550 on the day of registration. This payment will ensure that your child/ward receives textbooks for the year.

Please note the following:

- The R550 is a once off nonrefundable payment for the year 2021.
- This amount must be paid on the day of registration.
- Textbooks are on loan and must be returned at the end of the year so that the following year's Grade 8s may be loaned the same books.
- The cost of the books if you were to purchase this on your own will be well in excess of R1600.
- In order for the scheme to work, lost or damaged books must be replaced or paid for in full at the end of each year.
- The collection of text books will take place for each subject on the day the last paper for that subject is written.
- You are required to sign and return the acknowledgment slip regarding the contents of this letter when you make the payment.
- Textbooks will not be issued in 2021 if this acknowledgement slip is not signed and returned.
- Once payment has been made, a receipt will be issued which must be produced when collecting textbooks.


